Unit III

Classification of industries; Industrial policy in India – Role of public and private sectors; Recent trends in Indian industrial growth; MNCs and transfer of technology; Liberalization and Privatization, Regional Industrial growth in India; Industrial economic concentration and remedial measures; Structure of industrial labour, employment dimensions of Indian Industry. Unit IV

Industrial Finance – Owned, external and other component of funds; Role, nature, volume and types of institutional finance – IDBI, IFCI, SFCs, SIDC, commercial banks, Assessment of financial soundless, ratio analysis. Cost – benefit analysis.

Unit V
