## Minutes of the Academic Council meeting held on 16 Nov. 2017


Hon'ble Vice chancellor extended a warm welcome to all the members of the council and directed to begin the proceedings of the meeting.

Item No.	Particulars
1	Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting of the council.
<b>Decision</b>	Minutes of the previous meeting of the council are approved.
2	Approval of the newly constituted Board of Studies.
<b>Decision</b>	The newly constituted Boards of Studies and Nominated Deans of Faculties were approved.
3	Approval of the ordinance recommended by an expert committee for the Ph.D. research programme in the university.
<b>Decision</b>	<p>A. The Academic Council approved the Ph.D. supervisors, as recommended by the three members expert committee as constituted for the purpose in its meeting on 10.10.2017.</p> <p>B. The ordinance 101 for the award of the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) prepared by a four member expert committee, which met on 30.10.2017 at Udaipur, was approved by the Academic Council.</p> <p>C. The Academic Council authorized the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor to nominate and register a qualified retired teacher as Ph.D. supervisor in special conditions in the interest of the students and the need of the area.</p>
4	Approval of the proposal to add the marks of the compulsory subjects (Hindi & English) in the total percentage of the candidate.
<b>Decision</b>	<p>The proposal of counting of the marks of the compulsory subjects of Hindi and English both in the total percentage of the candidate is was approved as under :-</p> <p>A. <b>General Hindi</b> will be taught in First Year at graduation level and the marks will be counted for total percentage of the candidate.</p> <p>B. <b>General English</b> will be taught in Second year at graduation level and marks will be counted for total percentage of the candidate.</p> <p>C. <b>The Environment Studies and Elementary Computer Application</b> subjects will be taught as usual in First year and Second year classes.</p>

5	Approval of the proposal to introduce General Knowledge paper at graduation level in Arts, Science, Commerce & Education as a compulsory paper.
<b>Decision</b>	As per the decision taken in the meeting of the faculty Deans held on 14.11.2017 a General Studies paper will be made compulsory in the Faculty of Education (B.Ed. 2 Years/ 4 Years Integrated Course) from the session 2018-19 and marks will be counted for total percentage of the candidate as under :- A. <b>General Studies (Rajasthan)</b> paper will be taught in the first year and <b>General Studies (National/ International Affairs)</b> will be taught in the Second year of the <b>B.Ed. Course (Two Years)</b> . The paper will be objective type. B. <b>General Studies (Rajasthan)</b> paper will be taught in the Third year and <b>General Studies (National/ International Affairs)</b> will be taught in the Last year of the Four year integrated course ( <b>B.A. B.Ed., B.Sc B.Ed.</b> ). The paper will be objective type.
6	Regarding Ex-Students.
<b>Decision</b>	A failure student of the First Year and Post Graduate Previous Classes of MohanLal Sukhadiya University, Udaipur in 2017 Examination, will be eligible to apply as an "EX STUDENT" for 2018 Examination in this university. For this the student will be required to submit the Migration Certificate and the student will have to Pass in all the Compulsory, Theory and Practical Exams. The marks obtain in the last exam will not be acceptable. This proposal is approved by the Academic Council.
