Applications are invited for admission to Ph.D. Programme in the Faculties of Science, Commerce, Management, Social Sciences, Humanities, Education also. Admission to the Ph.D. programme will be made through Research Entrance Test (RET) and interviews as per Ph.D. Regulations of the University based on U.G.C. Regulations-2018. The RET will be organised as per the ordinance O.101 of the university Application form and other details are available on the University website www.ggtu.ac.inwwwwww w.e.f. 27Jan,2021. Last date of submitting online application is 10 Feb, 2021.

ELIGIBILITY:- Postgraduate degree in the relevant subject with minimum 55% marks from a recognized University. A relaxation of 5% marks at the PG level will be given to SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer) / MBC (Non-creamy layer) and PH students. Students appearing in P.G. final year/ last semester of the current session may also apply, their admission will subject to fulfilling the eligibility criteria at the time of interview.

EXEMPTION: - candidates shall be exempted from the Research Entrance Test irrespective of their having qualified UGC/CSIR NET (JRF)/ SLET/GATE/M.Phil Programme as per UGC Regulation 2009.

RESERVATION: Subject-wise while allotting Supervisor against vacancies. Reservation as per Rajasthan Government rules. If candidates from reserved categories are not available, vacancies may be filled by General candidates as per the UGC rules.

SCHEME OF TEST:

The examination will consist of two papers. Each consisting of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) (Two mark of each question) and there will be no negative marking.

PAPER-I (duration 1 hours)

* For all subjects including Geography & Faculty of Science :-

The questions shall be of general nature, intended to assess the research aptitude of the candidate. It will primarily be designed to test Mathematical Reasoning & Aptitude, Teaching Aptitude, Research Aptitude, Communication, Comprehension, Logical Reasoning, Data Interpretation, ICT and People, Development & Environment, Higher Education System and general awareness of the candidate. A total of 50 multiple choice questions (MCQ) will be set. There will be no negative marking.

PAPER – II (duration 1 hours)

This paper will be separate for each subject and will consist of 50 MCQ. There will be no negative marking. The syllabus for this paper will be the same as that of UGC /CSIR NET examination and wherever not available, as uploaded on this website.

Paper – II will be evaluated only for those candidates who are able to secure the minimum qualifying marks in Paper-I as per the table given below:
